Bathrooms today are more functional. It's where we carry out a multitude of activities, each in their defined space.

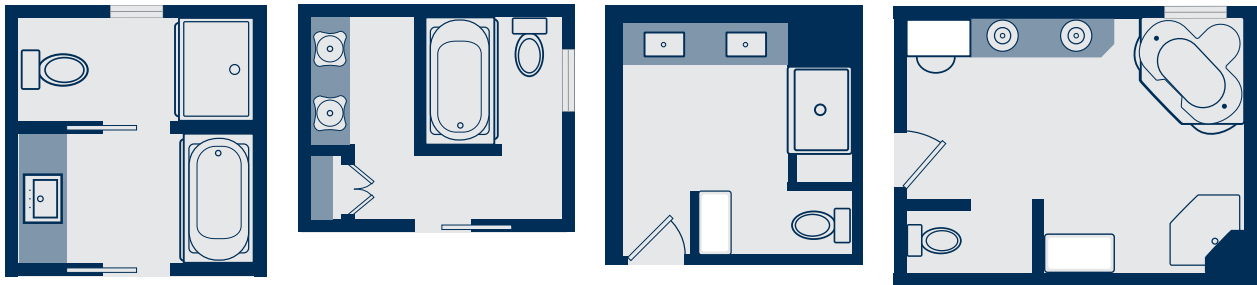
The logical sequence of your habits will guide the room's layout. For example, when stepping out of the shower, towels must be readily accessible without having to negotiate your way around the toilet.

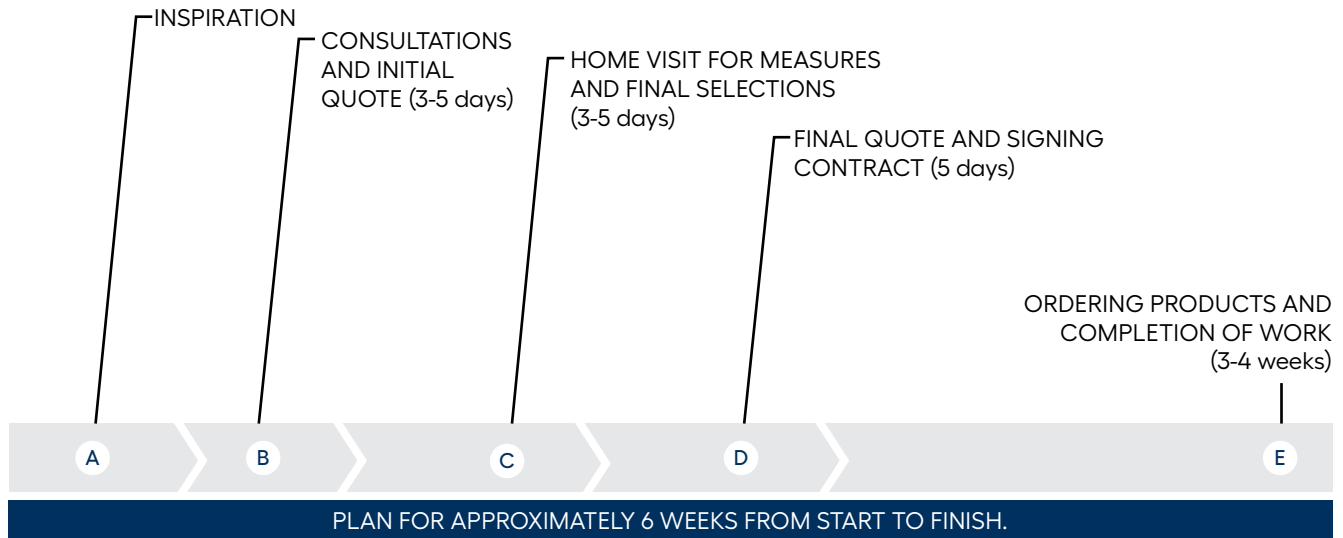

WHAT TO EXPECT

- 1- Do not begin any demolition or renovation work until the cabinets you have ordered have been delivered and inspected. The installer has the know-how to carry out demolition work in the most efficient way possible.
- 2- Empty your old drawers and cupboards before the installers arrive. Remove anything that is attached to the walls and clear the counters.
- 3- The first phase will be the demolition work, followed by plumbing and electricity. Then, the walls will be closed, and we will install the new bathroom elements (ceramic tiles, paint, finishing products and so on).
- 4- During installation, if the installers encounter a pre-existing or hidden problem which could undermine the integrity of your project, they will inform you and the store of this and will decide if the situation must be resolved before continuing the project. We will provide you with solutions, depending on the type of problem. If additional charges apply, you can make an informed choice before the work resumes.
- 5- If you have opted for custom cabinetry and countertops, expect to do without a washbasin for a few weeks. A delay may occur between installing your cabinets and preparing, delivering and installing your countertop. You can ask your installer to put in a temporary washbasin for an additional cost.
- 6- Although your installers make every effort to contain dust within the work area, some will most likely spread to other parts of your home. We apologize for the inconvenience and assure you that your new bathroom will make you forget these annoyances!
- 7- You may have to refrain from using the bathroom for a few days (toilet/shower/bathtub), despite our efforts to get the work done in a timely manner.
- 8- For safety reasons, please keep children and animals away from the work area.
- 9- Once the installation has been completed, the installers will do a final inspection with you to ensure that the results meet your expectations.

SKETCH THE PLAN

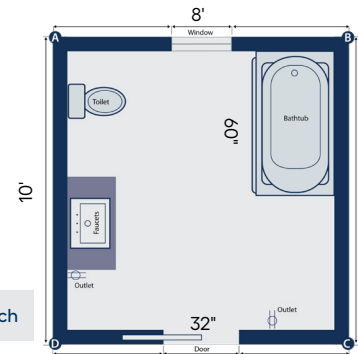
